Proof of English language skills for enrolment at the TH Wildau

The Senate of the Wildau University of Applied Sciences has, pursuant to § 6 subsection. 2 no. 2 of the Brandenburg Higher Education Act of 28.04.2014 (GVBl.I/14, [No. 18], p.1, Beschl.BVerfG GVBl.I/18 [No. 18]) last amended by law of 23.09.2020 (GVBl.I/20, [No. 26]) and in accordance with § 10 para. 1 of the Basic Regulations of Wildau University of Applied Sciences of 21.08.2019 Official Notice 45/2019 last amended on 07.04.2020 (Official Notice 3/2020), issued the following directive on 19.07.2022:

Preamble

For some degree programmes, English language skills at a certain level of competence must be proven by means of school reports or language certificates for matriculation. Information on which degree programmes this applies to can be found in the respective study and examination regulations of the degree programme.

§ 1

1. The language level stated on the school leaving certificate according to the "Common European Framework of Reference for Languages" (CEFR) is in principle binding¹.
2. Language certificates of higher competence levels of the respective language are automatically recognised as certificates for lower competence levels.
3. Proof of English language skills is also accepted if applicants can prove that they have acquired their higher education entrance qualification or a higher education degree in English.
4. in case of doubt, a language teacher from the Language Centre of the Wildau University of Applied Sciences will make a decision on a case-by-case basis to ensure that the required language level for the degree programme is met.
