**Admission and Enrolment Regulations
for the degree programme in Mobility and Administration
(Bachelor of Science – B.Sc.)
dual degree programme with integrated internships**

Pursuant to Section 15(3)(4) and Section 81(2)(1) of the Brandenburg Higher Education Act of 9 April 2024 (GVBl.I/24, No. 12), as last amended on 21 June 2024 (GVBl.I/24, No. 30) in conjunction with Section 14(3) of the Basic Regulations of Technische Hochschule Wildau – Technical University of Applied Sciences, as published on 21 August 2019 (Official Notices of Technische Hochschule Wildau No. 45/2019), last amended with effect from 22 August 2022 (Official Notices No. 29/2022) and the provisions of the General Regulations of Technische Hochschule Wildau – Technical University of Applied Sciences of 4 July 2019 (Official Notices No. 42/2019), last amended on 29 May 2024 (Official Notices of Technische Hochschule Wildau – Technical University of Applied Sciences No. 12/2024), the Faculty Board of the Faculty of Engineering and Natural Sciences at Technische Hochschule Wildau – Technical University of Applied Sciences, by resolution of 8 June 2026, hereby issues the following Entry and Admission Regulations for the degree programme in Mobility and Management, approved by the President of Technische Hochschule Wildau – Technical University of Applied Sciences by letter dated 9 June 2026:

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Section 1

Scope

These Regulations govern admission to the dual degree programme with integrated internships in Mobility and Administration at Technische Hochschule Wildau – Technical University of Applied Sciences for all students commencing their degree programmes from Winter Semester 2026/2027 onwards.

Section 2

Entry Requirements, Selection Procedure

- (1) Admission to the degree programme is open to those who
 - a) hold a university admission qualification in accordance with the Brandenburg Higher Education Act (BbgHG),
 - b) have signed a study contract with the Ministry of Infrastructure and Regional Planning of the State of Brandenburg (MIL) or another admissions authority, and
 - c) have been registered by the MIL within the framework of the student intake quota agreed with the Faculty of Engineering and Natural Sciences.
- (2) The procedure for selecting suitable applicants is carried out by the MIL or another recruiting authority under its own authority and responsibility. The final assessment of the entry requirements and the decision on the admission of the selected applicants in accordance with the BbgHG rests with Technische Hochschule Wildau – Technical University of Applied Sciences.
- (3) Admission shall be revoked if the student's contractual relationship with the MIL or another appointing authority has been legally terminated and a new study contract has not been signed within twelve weeks.

Section 3

Admission for professionally qualified individuals

- (1) For applications made on the basis of Secs.10(2), Sent. 1, No. 11 of the BbgHG, the vocational training programmes listed in the Appendix to these regulations shall be regarded as suitable.
- (2) The degree programme director at Technische Hochschule Wildau – Technical University of Applied Sciences shall decide on the subject-matter compatability of vocational training programmes with a title other than those listed in the Appendix to these regulations.
- (3) Before any study contracts with applicants who are to be granted access to higher education in accordance with Secs. 10(2), Sent. 1, No. 11 of the BbgHG are signed, approval must be granted by the person responsible at Technische Hochschule Wildau – Technical University of Applied Sciences for the decision under paragraph 2.
- (4) For vocational training programmes listed in the Annex to these regulations, approval shall be deemed to have been granted.

Section 4

Admission for international applicants

To gain admission to this degree programme, foreign applicants and stateless persons must additionally demonstrate their language proficiency for the purposes of study, in accordance with Secs. 10(1), Sent. 3, and (3), Sent. 1, of the BbgHG. Such proof is deemed to have been provided if they have acquired the qualification required for the degree programme in accordance with Secs. 10(2), Sent. 1, nos. 1 to 4 of the BbgHG in Germany or at a German school abroad, provided that this was not acquired exclusively under foreign law, or if they have passed the German Language Examination for Universities (DSH) with an overall result of DSH-2 or higher.

Section 5

Entry into force

These regulations shall come into force on the day following their publication in the Official Notices of Technische Hochschule Wildau – Technical University of Applied Sciences.
