THE FIRST OWN HOME - LIVING IN A RESIDENCE HALL



Your studies in Potsdam, Brandenburg an der Havel or Wildau are about to start and you are still looking for a place to stay? In our 18 residence halls we offer the right accommodation for every need – whether it is a one-room apartment, a shared apartment, barrier-free housing, or rooms for students with children. As a fair landlord, we offer you all-inclusive rentals, a short minimum rental period and an easy application procedure without proof of income.

With us, you pay an average rent of 285 € per month, including all service charges. The deposit is 300 €. Our residences are located close to the universities – you can get cheap internet access via the university network or directly through the Studentenwerk. Washing machines and dryers are available in all residence halls, as well as sufficient car and bicycle parking spaces. And no one needs to be alone! Our residence worker and our residence tutors support community life in the residence halls, and our care takers offer hands-on help and advice.



MAP: Overview in Potsdam






APPLY IN JUST A FEW CLICKS FOR A PLACE IN A RESIDENCE HALL

The demand for affordable housing is high. Therefore, apply as early as possible for one of our places in the residence halls - even if you have not yet received the admission letter of your university! This is how it works:

- Apply online

 For the summer semester 2024 you can apply from October 1, 2023. For the winter semester 2024/25 you can start applying on April 1, 2024. Apply here: studentenwerk-potsdam.de/en/housing/online-application-residences
- Receive confirmation by e-mail and save it

 We will check whether you are eligible for housing and then send a confirmation via e-mail (this may take a few days). Keep this email for later use. Always quote your application number in all correspondence.
- Send notifications from the university to the Studentenwerk
 You have received your letter of admission and a certificate of enrollment?
 Congratulations! Send them to us via email as a reply to the confirmation email.
- Received an offer? Confirm directly!

 You have received an offer for a place in the residence hall? Please confirm with us via email using your rental number until the specified response date. Later answers cannot be considered.

FIND AN APARTMENT MORE EASILY

Here we have compiled some pieces of advice to help you increase your chances of finding an apartment:

> Are you looking for a place in the residence hall?
If you are flexible in your choice of residence and type of housing, your chances will increase.

> You didn't get a room?

Unfortunately, we do not have places in our residence halls for all students. On our website we provide information about alternatives:

Live inexpensively in Potsdam and do good at the same time – both is possible in our project "Homesharing"!

> Are you looking for apartments on the free market for the first time?

Do not forget to ask for a rent guarantee from your parents. Cheap apartments are sometimes only available with a certificate of eligibility for housing (WBS). You can apply for this at your municipality:

- potsdam.de (German only)
- stadt-brandenburg.de (German only)
- wildau.de (German only)
- > Residence hall, a room in a private shared apartment or your own apartment?
 In all three cases: Take care of it early!

MOVING INTO A NEW LIFE

You did it! The moving boxes are unpacked and your studies are about to begin. In order to make studying more relaxed, a few things still need to be taken care of.

> Register your place of residence at the citizens' office within 14 days after moving in

- potsdam.de (German only)
- stadt-brandenburg.de (German only)
- wildau.de (German only)

> Can you be exempted from broadcasting fees?

If you are entitled to BAföG, you can be exempted from the mandatory fee: **rundfunkbeitrag.de** (German only). Otherwise, an apartment (or shared apartment) has to pay a contribution of 18.36 € per month.

> Check entitlement to housing allowance

If you do not receive BAföG, you may be entitled to housing allowance ("Wohn-geld"). For the application for housing allowance, you will need the notice of rejection of BAföG. You can apply for housing allowance at the city or municipality.

SUPPORT IN THE RESIDENCE HALL: RESIDENCE WORKER AND RESIDENCE TUTORS

Are you new in town and full of questions? Our residence worker is there to help and advise students in the residence halls. As a contact person on site, he is close to everyday life on campus and knows the needs of the students. He provides support regarding good cohabitation and mediates in conflicts. Our tutors live in the residence halls themselves and come from Germany and all over the world. The residence tutors receive an expense allowance for their voluntary work. We are regularly looking for new tutors for our residence halls.

MONEY FOR YOUR STUDIES - BAFÖG, SCHOLARSHIPS & CO.

Studying costs money. We advise you on how to finance your studies.

BAföG, jobbing, financial support from parents, scholarships or student loans - there are several ways to finance your studies. Often it is a mixture of different financing sources.

Our BAföG office team is happy to advise you and support you in applying for BAföG funding!

WHO GETS BAFÖG?

German students can receive BAföG, and under certain conditions international students are eligible as well, if they have a certain residence status. BAföG is paid if the student's own income and assets, as well as the income of his or her spouse/life partner and parents, are not sufficient to finance his or her studies. However, only those who have not yet reached the age of 45 at the start of their studies are eligible. But also in this case, certain exceptions apply to the rule (e.g. childcare, second-chance education, etc.).



*Please note that recently prices have increased due to inflation

HOW MUCH BAFÖG DO I GET?

The calculation consists of several factors: Your own income (e.g. from a part-time job) and assets are taken into account, as well as the income of your parents or spouse or partner. The maximum rate is currently $934 \in$ (incl. additional allowance for health and long-term care insurance) if you live in your own home, or $633 \in$ if you live at your parents' home.

GOOD TO KNOW

You are studying in Germany but do not have the German citizenship? In this case, the legal regulations of section 8 of the Federal Training Assistance Act (§ 8 BAföG) apply. Please contact us personally, so that we can counsel you. International students with a residence permit according to section 16 of the Residence Act (§ 16 Aufenthaltsgesetz) are unfortunately not entitled to BAföG.

HOW CAN I APPLY FOR BAFÖG?

You can easily submit the application online using the digital application assistant "BAföG Digital". You only need to open a user account for this. You can also subsequently upload missing documents via the online portal. Advantage: The documents are directly linked to your funding case and transmitted via a secure communication channel.

Once you have been informed of your grant number in our first letter, you can also easily upload missing documents via the "BAföG*direkt*" app. It is generally not possible to send documents and attachments via e-mail.

If the documents are complete, the processing time is about eight weeks. The follow-up application should also be submitted in time. Usually, a granted request is valid for 12 months. The application forms seem too complicated? Don't worry. During in-person and phone office hours, our team at the BAföG office is happy to help you fill out the forms. If any documents are still missing, we will get in touch with you!

GOOD TO KNOW

Even if you are not eligible for BAföG, it can be helpful in some cases if you have received a rejection notice, for example when applying for housing allowance or unemployment payment.

Rental proof of own apartment by means of a registration certificate or a rental contract

PROOF OF HEALTH AND/OR LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE

In case you are self-insured (with indication of the legal basis for the insurance)

• FORM 03

separate income declaration of the parents and/or if applicable of the marriage partner/life partner (attach the documents in full)

• OTHER FORMS IF APPLICABLE

- Form 04 (children of the person in education)
- Form 08 (application for advance payment according to section 36 BAföG, etc.)
- Follow-up application? Then use form 09 (for applications for further funding without a change in personal or financial circumstances compared to the previous application).

FURTHER FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES:



For those who wish to study but do not receive BAföG funding, other options to finance their academic education are available.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Only the best of the best receive a scholarship? That's not true! The committed, the convinced and many others can also apply successfully for a scholarship. The website www2.daad.de/deutschland/stipendium/datenbank/en/21148-scholarship-database/provides an overview.

EDUCATION LOAN

Are you in an advanced stage of your education or in an additional, postgraduate or supplementary course of study? Then you can take advantage of the low-interest education loan from the Federal Office of Administration. This loan is issued for a maximum of 24 months with up to 300 € per month. In contrast to BAföG, the loan is independent of the student's and parents' assets and income.

KFW STUDENT LOAN

Students in their first or second-degree program can apply for the KfW student loan. Here, between 100 and 650 € are granted per month for a period of up to 14 semesters by the KfW Bank as a full interest-bearing loan. Take into account that the interest rates are high.

GRADUATION LOANS

Already on the finishing straight? In order to finance the completion of their first-degree or consecutive studies at a state university, students in the area of responsibility of the Studentenwerk Potsdam can receive an interest-free loan for a maximum of 12 months. The graduation loan is intended for students who can successfully complete their studies in a maximum of two semesters and who are not (or no longer) entitled to BAföG support. Applications for the loan are submitted at the Studentenwerk Potsdam.

BALANCING STUDIES AND WORK



The job placement service of the Studentenwerk

You want to network early and gain professional experience? You are not entitled to BAföG? There are many reasons for a part-time job! A large number of students work besides their studies. Simply register via our job portal. When looking for a part-time job, many questions arise for the first time: Do I have to insure myself? Which work models are suitable for me? Will I lose my entitlement to BAföG if I get a job?

THIS IS HOW OUR JOB PLACEMENT SERVICE WORKS:

1. Register online

Required documents:

- > current certificate of enrollment
- > copy of student ID
- > if applicable, work permit for international students

2. Search for a part-time job

In our job portal you can search for a part-time job that suits you.

You will then receive the employer's contact details from us by e-mail as a referral note and you can apply for the iob.



You haven't registered yet?

Simply fill out the form online and start looking for a job. (German only)





Jobs as IT student trainee, mini-jobs in a PR agency or a semester vacation job in the catering industry: there are around 160 jobs in the online database every day. jobvermittlung.studentenwerk-potsdam.de (German only)



3. Update your registration

If you would like to remain registered with the job placement service, please send us a current certificate of enrollment at the start of each new semester. Otherwise your data will be deleted from our system.

4. Unsubscribe

You are no longer studying? Please inform us about your exmatriculation. This will enable us to unsubscribe you from the job placement service and your data will be deleted.

GOOD TO KNOW

Those who receive BAföG can earn up to 520 € per month in a side job without deductions (exemption amount).



WORKING AS AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT

For many international students, a part-time job is a regular part of their study life. There are no restrictions for EU citizens. They are allowed to work up to 20 hours a week. For students from so-called third countries, the amount of work depends on the residence permit. As a rule, it is a residence permit for study purposes. With this, a maximum of 120 full days per year or 240 half days per year can be worked.

In order to be able to work in a part-time job, the following documents/proofs must be provided:

- Work permit
- Health insurance chip card
- Tax identification number
- Social security card
- bank account
- Identity card or passport, if necessary with residence permit
- References and work samples (if requested by employer)
- A separate tax number is required for freelance jobs



RIGHTS IN A PART-TIME JOB

No matter what form of employment you pursue: In terms of labor laws, the same regulations that apply to employees apply to students as well.

- Right to a written employment contract
- Entitlement to six weeks continued payment of wages in the event of illness
- Payment of the minimum wage (currently 12.00 €/h, starting January 2024: 12.41 €/h)
- Paid vacation entitlement
- Compliance with the notice period
- Affordable counselling for 15 € at the local courts in case of dispute with the employer
- Protection against dismissal in the event of pregnancy



Daycare centers in Potsdam and Wildau

Up to 110 children from three months to school age are cared for at the "klEinstein" daycare center in Potsdam. The daycare center is located on the ground floor of the residence hall Kaiser-Friedrich-Straße near the campus of the University of Potsdam, Neues Palais. The daycare center "Die wilde 19" on the campus of the Technical University of Applied Sciences Wildau (house 19) offers space for up to 28 children aged two months or older.

- > You need less than 1,500 € to realize the project? In this case, the Studentenwerk management can make a decision on the application any time.
- > You need more than 1,500 €? In this case, the board of directors has to decide. The board meets three times per year. Your project documents have to be submitted to us at least six weeks before the meeting. You can find the current dates on our website.
- > The project application consists of: cover letter, project description, financing plan, letter of endorsement from the student council




GOOD TO KNOW

CHECKLIST FOR A SUCCESSFUL START OF YOUR STUDIES IN THE WINTER SEMESTER

JANUARY - MARCH: STILL BE WITHOUT A PLAN

- **Y** What do I want to study?
- When do I need to apply for the study program I have chosen?
- **⊘** Where would I like to study?
- What options do I have to finance my studies?
- Yes How much am I allowed to earn while studying?
- **⊘** Do my parents support me financially?

APRIL-JUNE: MAKE A PLAN

- **Funding:** Clarify financing options for studies (BAföG, parents, part-time job, scholarship)
- Apply online for a place in the residence hall at your preferred location (admission letter of the university can be submitted later)
- **Housing:** Get an overview of different housing options (free housing market, checking real estate platforms, ask at housing cooperatives and societies).
- **Solution** ✓ **Jobbing:** Do I need a part-time job? What is the time required (full-time study: no more than 20h/week)? What do I want and what can I deliver besides my studies?



JULY-SEPTEMBER: HAVE THE MASTER (OR BACHELOR) PLAN

- **Financing:** Submit your BAföG application (processing takes approx. 8 weeks), consider applying for a scholarship
- **Housing:** Send admission letter from the university to the Studentenwerk so that a rental offer can be made (indicate your online application number)
- **Solution** Jobbing: Find a part-time job through our job placement service
- Insurance: What insurance coverage do I have and which one do I need (important: health and liability insurance)?

OCTOBER - DECEMBER: PUT YOUR PLAN INTO ACTION

- **Financing:** Notification on the BAföG decision
- → Housing: Move in, register your new residence with the city administration (usually deadline of one week), submit a forwarding request to the post office, register for the broadcasting fee
 - **Tip:** If you receive BAföG, you can be exempted from the fees.
- And what else: Attend information events, apply for your student ID, visit the canteen for the first time, maybe have a counselling session, follow and like us on social media, explore your new place of residence we wish you good luck at the start of your studies!
