ACCOMMODATION Living in the residence hall



- The Studierendenwerk
 West:Brandenburg provides
 accommodation in 18 residence halls in
 Brandenburg
- Demand for rooms in the residence halls is extremely high, they only have space for approximately 10% of all students
- 4 residence house in Wildau: for WiSe 25/26 all rooms taken
- Application for next SoSe 25 possible around November

- ✓ Contact the caretaker ASAP after arrival
- ✓ Inform the caretaker if you notice any existing damage
- ✓ Collect the "Wohnungsgeberbestätigung" from him

- The monthly rent is due on the first day of the month, and the Studierendenwerk must receive the payment by the third day of the month at the latest



First steps after arriving in Germany



Registering at the registration office: First steps in Germany

Immediately after your arrival in Germany, you must register with the relevant registration office (Einwohnermeldeamt or Bürgeramt). This registration is required by law and must be completed within two weeks of moving into your new home. When you register, you will receive confirmation of your registration certificate, which is required for many official matters.


